

## **William G. McGowan Scholarship Evaluation Criteria**

**All application materials must be submitted to the College of Business Dean's Office in the Combs Building, Room 214 by March 2, 2009.**

Your application will be judged by a panel of business faculty who will be considering the following:

- Your overall academic performance (20 points)
  - GPA
  - Academic honors, awards, or recognition
- Letter of recommendation from faculty member (10 points)
- Your civic/community involvement (15 points)
- Evidence of leadership (15 points)
- Your essays (40 points)

The top three student applicants, based on these scoring criteria, will be interviewed by the College of Business Dean and the Department Chair of Information Systems. These interviews, worth 25 points, will be added to the overall score to assist the dean in selecting the scholarship award winner.

The student selected to receive the William G. McGowan scholarship will be recognized at the College of Business Annual Student Honor's Banquet on May 1, 2009.
