**Course Content:** Exercises and solo literature appropriate to the area of percussion study.

**Instructor's Expectations:** Percussion majors are expected to practice privately 2 hours per day and should successfully progress over the course of a semester based on their background and ability. Each student will be required to perform a 'jury' during finals week of that semester. Progress will be verbally evaluated each week with the student.
