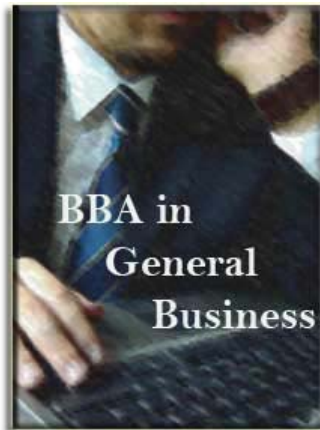

Spring 2008 Advance Registration, November 5-8, 2008

Registration for Spring 2008 will begin on November 5 and continue through November 8. The information below outlines the steps to follow to Register:

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE:

1. Clear all holds prior to Registration (ex. \$50 drop fee)
2. Schedule an advising session with your academic adviser. If you do not know how to locate your academic adviser, contact the department of your major.

3. Verify with your adviser that you are approved to register.

4. Input your schedule by following the directions below:



Access MSU's Website at www.moreheadstate.edu

1. Click on Current Students then click Online Services.
2. Select Datatel Webadvisor Secure Login and log in using your MSU ID & password.
3. Select option 1: "Search and Register for Sections" then select a term then select 1 additional criterion. Choose courses from your search selection. After making all course selections Click Submit. Courses are now in your preferred list or "Shopping Cart." You can now or at a later date determine the action you want to take to register for the courses in your preferred list.
4. To register for the courses in your preferred list, select one action to apply to all courses or select an action for each individual course. Selecting "Complete Only Available" at the bottom of the page will register you for any open classes when you Click Submit. If you select "Allow me to adjust all", you will not be registered for any courses until all courses with conflicts have been adjusted.

Select Option 2: Express Registration if you have a planned list of classes. You will need to add the term the course is offered.

After you have completed the online registration process, go back to the student menu, select "My class schedule" under the academic profile and verify that your schedule is correct. You may print your schedule at this time. If necessary, you have go back and repeat the above steps to correct any errors.

Scholarships

student bills have been paid in full, scholarship monies may be used to cover school related expenses such as books, TRAVEL, child care, etc...

Scholarship Criteria include:

- » Recipients should be taking (6) or more hours at the extended campus or recipients must have completed a minimum of (16) hours of coursework at the Mt. Sterling campus and are completing coursework on the Morehead Campus.
- » Recipients shall maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.75.

- » The scholarship may be renewed if academic criteria are met.
