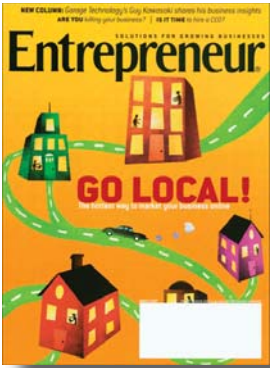

Forest, meets on Fridays from 5:00-9:00 pm and Saturdays from 9:00 am - 1:00 pm for three weekends beginning November 16th (excluding Thanksgiving weekend). This is a course about a forest and how it represents both possibility and loss. Students will learn the history of the Daniel Boone area as well as facts about its creation and

administration as a government reserve. Students will develop an appreciation of the difficulties and opportunities inherent in public ownership of cultural resource. Both of these classes are 3 credit hour classes.

## Summer Drug Awareness Seminar Scheduled

MSU at Mt. Sterling will host an all-day seminar on Thursday, June 21st provided by the Drug Endangered Child Training Network located at the University of Kentucky. The Drug Endangered Child (DEC) Training Network is an Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) funded project that seeks to increase community and professional awareness of the impact of adult drug involvement on childrens.

This seminar will explain the problems that Kentucky has with drugs in the household and its effects on children living in those households. Statistics provided by the Kentucky Cabinet of Health and Family Services show that in 2004, approximately 76% of the child fatalities in which abuse and neglect were sustained were related to
