Events may include but are not limited to: dance, theater, various diversity topics, Black History Month events, Hispanic Heritage Month events, art and literature, etc.

\_\_\_\_\_ Special Events Coordinator-This position would chair the annual Dance Marathon program. In addition this position would serve as an assistant to the Student Activities Coordinator helping implement annual events including but not limited to: Family Weekend Tailgate, Homecoming Student Party, Make a Difference Day Service Project, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day of Service, President's Lawn Concert and New Student Days.
