Purpose: To address the awarding of military credit

Scope (Who Is Covered By This UAR?): Service members requesting college credit from military experiences.

Description: As a Service member Opportunity College (SOC), Morehead State University awards military credits in accordance with SOC and American Council on Education (ACE) guidelines. Therefore, military credit will be awarded after careful analysis by academic departments to determine the comparability of the learning outcomes of the military course and the course at the University for which credit is being sought.

MILITARY OCCUPATIONAL SPECIALTY AND OTHER MILITARY CREDIT:

When a service member presents documentation of Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) or other military credit to the Registrar and requests Morehead State University credit, the Registrar will route the request to the department chair of the service member's program of study for evaluation until an equivalency list has been established.

MONITORING: The University Undergraduate Curriculum Committee will review the procedure annually and recommend changes to the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS: Academic residency requirements will be no more than 50 percent of the undergraduate degree program for service members.
