**PURPOSE:** To address the awarding of military credit.

**PROCEDURAL REFERENCES:**

BOR - Undergraduate Admissions Standards

**SCOPE (Who is covered by this UAR?):** Service members requesting college credit from military experiences. This UAR is to take effect with the fall 1993 semester.

**DESCRIPTION:**

As a Service members Opportunity College (SOC), Morehead State University awards military credits in accordance with SOC and American Council on Education (ACE) guidelines. Therefore, military credit will be awarded after careful analysis by academic departments to determine: 1) the comparability of the learning outcomes of the military course and the course at the University for which credit is being sought and 2) the appropriateness and applicability of the credit to the student's educational program of study.

**MILITARY OCCUPATIONAL SPECIALTY AND OTHER MILITARY CREDIT:**

When a service member presents documentation of Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) or other military credit to the Registrar and requests Morehead State University credit, the Registrar will route the request to the department chair of the service member's program of study for evaluation. A maximum of sixteen (16) hours of MOS or other military credit may be awarded. Credit may be awarded only for courses that correspond to courses in the service member's declared program of study.

**BASIC TRAINING:** A maximum of four (4) hours of "K" credit will be awarded for Basic Training or DD 214 toward the general education requirements in health and physical education.

**CAMP CHALLENGE:** A maximum of four (4) hours of credit will be awarded as proficiency credit for MS 101 and MS 102.

**MONITORING:** The University Undergraduate Curriculum Committee will review the procedure annually and recommend changes to the Vice President for Academic Affairs.
